



NEW Galapagos Safari Camp, Santa Cruz, Galápagos Islands

Owners Stephanie and Mesdag visited these islands before they married, and while cycling in the highlands of Santa Cruz – the largest island in the Galápagos archipelago – found a farm with panoramic views of the Pacific and islands to the north and west. They bought it, moved here and turned a farm of coffee, guavas and bananas into South America's first luxury tented safari camp.
